Project in Review: Hallett Cove Boardwalk









DESCRIPTION

A new 128m boardwalk was built connecting the reserve to the Field River mouth. The project was part of the Marion Council Coastal Walkway upgrade and extension. APR Composites material was selected as the best option for exposed environments that require durable components for safe public use.

APR Composites was used to build:

- Substructure (posts, joists, bracing, bearers)
- Decking
