- ✓ **2,700 kg** of reclaimed non-treated timber consumed
- ✓ **2,700 kg** of recycled plastic consumed
- ✓ = **70,000** x 2 litre plastic milk bottles
- ✓ = **195 m³** of plastic diverted from landfill
